

Expanding Operations in Indonesia



PT. OOCL Logistics Indonesia continues its expansion with a new 20,000 square meters warehouse in Jakarta. The facility began operations early 2014 and brings the company's total warehousing space in Indonesia to approximately 35,000 square meters including both bonded and non-bonded facilities.

This latest facility is located 40 km from the port of Jakarta and is in close proximity to major highways connecting industrial districts, which enables efficient handling of export and import cargo and domestic distribution.

Aside from the storage functions for chemicals, auto parts, apparel, food and other products, the warehouse handles processes

from the receiving of raw materials, to assembling, other value-added services and customs clearance.

The facility also complies with CTPAT, ISO 9001: 2008 and high quality control standards, enabling safe and efficient warehouse operations for our customers. A racking system installation is expected to be completed in Q2 2014.

Supplementary land located 8km from the port has also been secured for further expansion that will bring our total space to 55,000 square meters this year.

By combining the functions of our existing warehouses and the new facility, OOCL Logistics will provide a wider range of services that further cover upstream and downstream supply chains operations.

Sri Lanka Prohibits THCs



The Sri Lankan government has asked shipping lines not to collect terminal handling charges (THC) and other surcharges beginning in January 2014.

President Mahinda Rajapaksa said "In order to prevent the monopoly of pricing in the shipping trade, no shipping line will be permitted to levy terminal handling and other charges in addition

to freight and specified international charges for containerised cargo. This prohibition will be made effective through amendments to the Finance Act, effective January 2014".

Beyond this government action, Sri Lankan shippers will start paying an all-in freight rate and any amendments or penalty incurred by the shipper will only be as a result of the shippers' negligence.

"(4) Any such existing contract not so revised shall be deemed to be null and void to the extent of the application of these regulations, with effect from April 30, 2014."

Sri Lanka first introduced a THC in 1994 on import cargo. Before that the THC was included in the freight. The Sri Lanka Shippers' Council (SLSC) says the THC has made Sri Lanka's exports uncompetitive and has cost the country billions of Rupees on imports and exports.

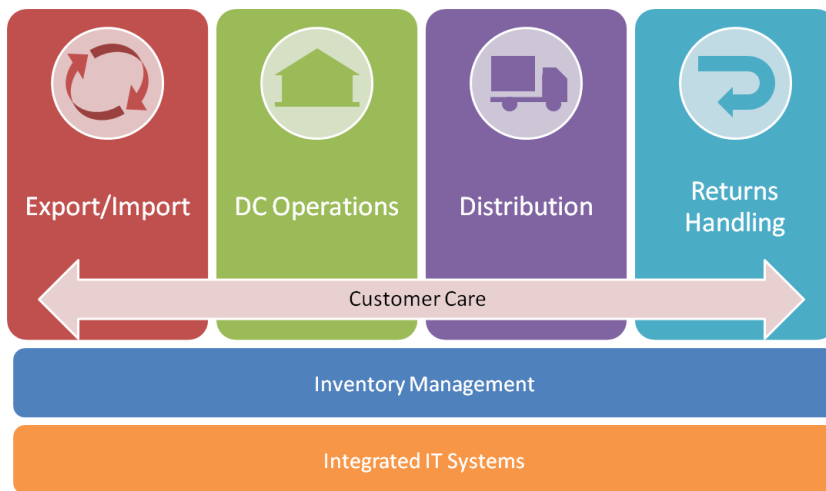
